Application deadlines	Semester 1 : application due by April 30 <sup>th</sup> Semester 2 : application due by October 31 <sup>st</sup>
Application procedure	After students have been officially nominated by their home institution and ECAM Lyon has been informed accordingly, ECAM Lyon sends a specific application form to the students. It has to be completed and returned with a detailed CV and latest transcript of records.

Programs of study	Exchange students can enroll in : <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- <b>One or two semesters of study</b> in the “Arts &amp; Métiers” Program in General Engineering (no specialization) taught in French or in the new “ECAM Engineering” Program in Mechanical &amp; Electrical Engineering <u>entirely taught in English</u> (Year 1 launched in September 2016). The semester students complete at ECAM Lyon depends on their current level of studies.</li> <li>- <b>A double degree</b> if an official agreement has been signed between ECAM Lyon and their home institution.</li> <li>- <b>A Master’s research project</b> in one of ECAM’s departments: Energy, Material &amp; Structures, Industrial Management, Automation &amp; Computer Science.</li> <li>- <b>The IPL international Summer School</b> in Science and Engineering <a href="http://www.iplsummerschool.com/">http://www.iplsummerschool.com/</a></li> </ul>
Language requirements	<b>B1</b> in French for the General Engineering program (taught in French) <b>B2</b> in English for the International Program in Mechanical & Electrical Engineering (taught in English) <b>B2</b> in English for students doing a research project (if they do not speak French) or applying for the IPL Summer School.
French language courses	It is possible to take French language courses before the beginning and throughout the semester. Courses will take place in a partner school of ECAM Lyon. Tuition fees are taken care of by ECAM Lyon.

Health insurance	<a href="https://www.campusfrance.org/en/healthcare-student-social-security">https://www.campusfrance.org/en/healthcare-student-social-security</a> Incoming students are required to have a complete insurance coverage throughout their stay in France. Formalities depend on the country of origin. Students from European countries will have to bring a valid European insurance card and will need additional coverage including repatriation and civil liability insurance. For non-European students it is compulsory to be affiliated to the French Social Security system for the on-going academic year (around 215 euros/year) and additional coverage including repatriation and civil liability will also be needed. The ECAM Lyon international office will help incoming students with all the insurance issues.
